The correct answer is: A. 72 inches.

1 foot is 12 inches, so $6 \times 12 = 72$.

7. The scale of this map is 1 cm to 2 miles. How many miles is it from A to B?

$$2 \times 2 = 4$$
.

8. This map uses a scale of 2 cm for 1 mile. Jan went from the Station to the Art Gallery. How many miles was that?

The correct answer is: B. 2 miles. You need to divide the measurement by 2.

$$4 \div 2 = 2$$
.

9. How far is it from Bristol to Dover?

The correct answer is: B. 205 miles. Go down the 'Bristol' column to the row ending in Dover.

10. How many miles is it from Cardiff to Preston?

The correct answer is: B. 210 miles. Look down the 'Cardiff' column until you come to the 'Preston' row and read off 210 miles.



Level B

1. Which of the following is not an imperial unit of measure?

The correct answer is: C. Gram. This is a metric unit of measure.

2. What imperial unit of measurement can be used to weigh yourself?

The correct answer is: C. lb

Ib is an abbreviation for pounds, an imperial unit which is used for weighing a person (although sometimes stones are used).

3. What is the closest to the weight in stones?

The correct answer is: D. 13 stones is the closest to the reading in stones.

4. Which of the following is the closest to 27 inches?

The correct answer is: D. 69 cm

5. The journey Exeter to Hull and then on from Hull to Leeds is a total of:

The correct answer is: B. 365 miles

It's 305 + 60 = 365 miles.

6. This map has a scale of 1 cm = 15 miles. How far is it from A to C?

The correct answer is: C. 75 miles

 $5 \times 15 = 75$ miles.



7. Salah measured his journey (A to B to C) on a map with a scale of 1 cm = 5 miles. A to B was 12 cm and B to C was 8 cm, so he travelled:

The correct answer is: C. 100 miles

$$12 + 8 = 20$$
 cm.

$$20 \times 5 = 100$$

8. The distance from Cardiff to Hull, then on to Leeds is 309 miles.

The correct answer is: A. True

$$249 + 60 = 309$$

9. A return trip between Leeds and York would be:

The correct answer is: B. 48 miles

$$24 \times 2 = 48 \text{ miles}$$

10. From Hull to Leeds and on to Perth is 322 miles.

Hull to Leeds and on to Perth is 60 + 270 = 330.

$$42 \times 2 = 84$$
 miles.

It's 84 miles.

$$110 + 285 + 270 = 665$$
 miles.

The correct answer is: C. 570 miles

$$245 + 265 + 60 = 570$$
 miles.
